

## Things that would be helpful if your child knows/can do before coming into Kindergarten:

- ✓ Write their first name
- ✓ Identify the letters in their first name
- ✓ Say their ABC's
- ✓ Identify 8 basic colors
- ✓ Identify 4 basic shapes: square, rectangle, circle, triangle
- ✓ Count to 10 (20 would be great 😊) & count 10 objects
- ✓ Identify numbers 0-5
- ✓ Can hold up/identify finger amounts through 5 easily (10 would be great!)
- ✓ Can cut on a straight line
- ✓ Sit through a picture book being read to them
- ✓ Follow 2 step directions
- ✓ Put on and zip coat/clothes
- ✓ Blow own nose/take care of needs in the bathroom
- ✓ This is not necessary but being able to play very simple dice games with them- I have them play Candy Land but use a die instead of the color cards so they get used to subitizing (this is a fancy word for see a number of dots and knowing how many there are without having to count each one- like on a die 😊)

## Supply List for Kindergarten

- 2- Crayola Crayons, Box of 24 (It would be helpful if you initialed each crayon but not necessary) or 1 box of Crayola Twistables
- 2- Glue Bottles
- 4- Glue sticks
- 1 pk. #2 pencils-*please either buy pre-sharpened or sharpen them before bringing them in=)*
- 1 pk. 8 count washable markers
- 1 pair of children's scissors (with name written on them)
- 1pk of dry erase markers 4 count- black
- 2 pocket folders (with name written on them)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 Rolls of Paper towels
- 2 pk Clorox Wipes & 1 Magic Eraser
- 2 pk baby wipes
- 1 ream plain white paper
- 1 pencil bag (larger size) (with name written on it)
- 1 Backpack (with name written on it)
- 1 paint shirt (with name written on them)
- 1 change of clothes (complete set in Ziploc bag with name on bag- seasonal)
- 1 pair Gym Shoes
