

St. Mary's Catholic School of Kickapoo Tuition Information

St. Mary's School receives the spiritual and financial support of the entire parish.

Each enrolled student benefits from a portion of the educational cost
being subsidized by St. Mary's Parish.

Our school welcomes families from area parishes without their own schools
and families of other faiths to this learning community.

Families who are active, registered members of a Diocese of Peoria parish qualify for an additional
subsidy provided by their home parish to St. Mary's School, upon approval of their parish pastor.

**To maintain tuition status as a parish member, families with children attending St. Mary's School
are not only expected to pay tuition, but also should provide financial support
to the parish via weekly offering, while also regularly attending weekend Mass.**

Pre-K Tuition Rates

Children who will turn 3 or 4 on or before September 1st and are toilet trained, can be registered in our program.

A half day program is offered from 8:00 am to 11:30 am, at the cost of 2/3 of the full day rate.

There is a \$500 discount available for St. Mary's Parish families enrolling in
the 5 full day program and have other children attending St. Mary's in grades K-8th.
